



## Truxor DM 5000 Mechanical Weed, Algae and Leaf Litter Removal

Princeton Hydro, LLC is excited about our newest amphibious vehicle: the Truxor DM 5000. The size of a large pick-up truck, it is relatively light, produces very low ground pressure and is highly maneuverable.

The major benefit of the Truxor is that it represents a non-pesticide approach for the control of invasive weed and problematic algae growth. The Truxor can cut and harvest weeds and mat algae from near shore areas with water depths less than three feet and is capable of operating in any water depth and in wetland, marsh and riparian areas where conventional equipment access is limited.

Our Truxor is currently equipped with the following attachments:

- Weed cutter equipped with a collection basket for dual purpose cutting and removal of weeds
- Standard rake with strainer plates for removal of floating debris, cut vegetation, and mat algae
- Spring rake for collecting and removing vegetation and debris from along shorelines and outfall structures
- High tipping rake bucket for the collection and removal of leaf litter and woody debris
- Grip bucket for removing sediment, leaf litter and woody debris

Our Truxor can also be equipped with:

- Small excavator for clearing sediment and enlarging channels and ponds
- Suction dredger for removing accumulated sediments
- Cultivator for milling Phragmites rhizome mats and pre-planting areas
